

Fee Waiver Eligibility for ACT/SAT 2018-19 School Year

In order that finances not be an obstacle to students as they prepare for college, both the SAT and ACT organizations offer fee waivers for students with financial need so that they may take their college entrance exams for free.

Students must meet the following conditions to be eligible for fee waiver.

- Currently enrolled in 11th or 12th grade.
- Family's total annual income is at or below the USDA levels for reduced-price lunches listed on the chart below:

If these conditions are met, please see the counselor to receive fee waivers **before** registering for any tests. Fees paid are not refundable, even if you receive a fee waiver after you register.

Fee waivers may be used for a maximum of 2 ACT exams and 2 SAT exams.

In addition, students who take the SAT with a fee waiver will receive by mail 4 fee waivers to use on college applications, which is the maximum amount allowed. Most colleges will honor fee waivers, however it is at their discretion to do so.
