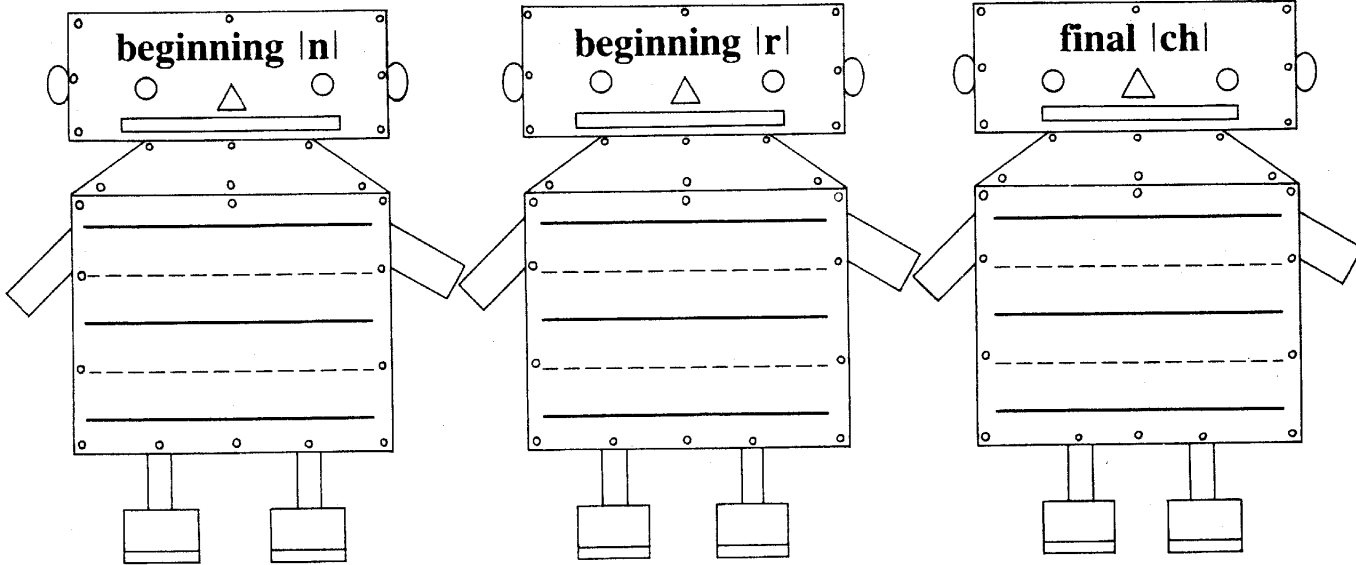
Summing Up
