Due Wednesday, Apr. 16

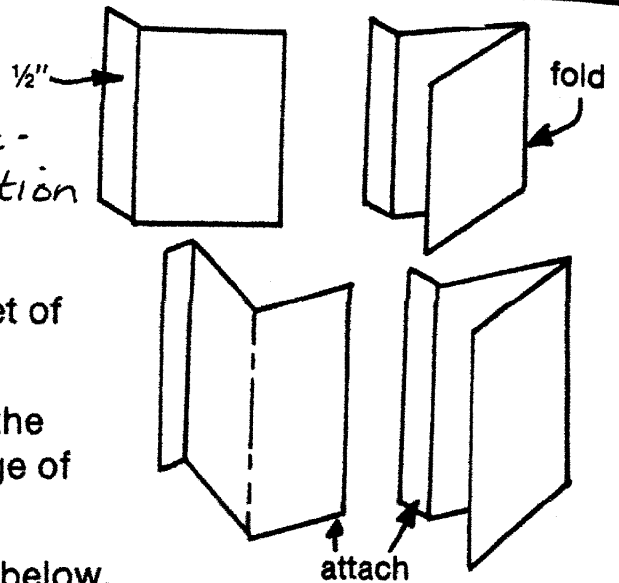
You need:

- 3 sheets of 9" X 12" construction paper
- crayons or markers
- glue or paste

Please use light-colored construction paper.

Directions:

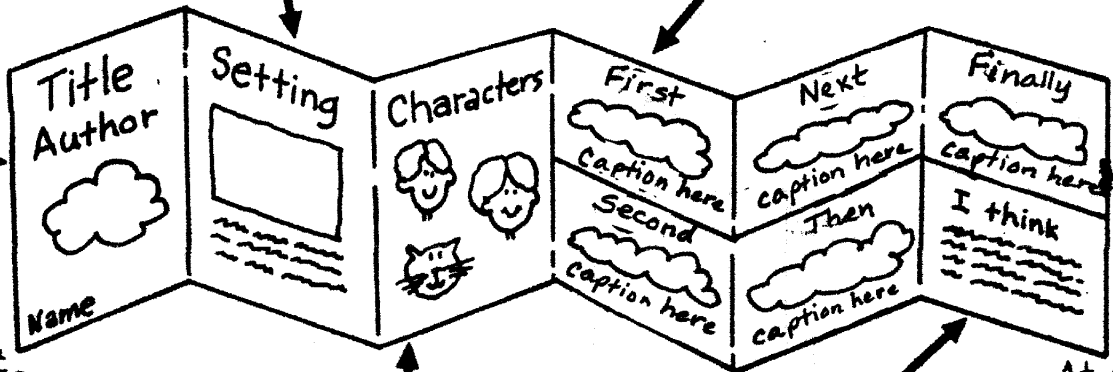
1. Fold a 1/2" edge along one side of each sheet of paper. Then fold the sheets in half.
2. Attach the three sheets together by gluing the folded edge of one sheet to the straight edge of the next.
3. Complete your fan-fold display as directed below.

Draw five pictures about the book in the spaces. Label them First, Second, Next, Then, and Finally.

Write the title, author, and your name. Add a picture.
