1. Absentee ballots will be counted on the first ballot only.
2. Absentee voters must qualify to vote by constitutional standards.
3. Absentee ballots must have the name of the voter on the envelope. If there is no name on the envelope, the ballot is considered invalid.
4. Three names must be chosen on each ballot.

You are welcome to drop off your absentee ballot at either the elementary office or the high school office during office hours any time before the meeting.

Class sizes are limited and registration will be open to the general public on April 23. If you have not registered prior to April 23 and the class is full, there will not be a spot for your child.
