Current K-12 Families with Potential Preschoolers: If you have children in grades K-12 at SCS and have a child you plan to enroll in Preschool for the 2019-2020 school year, IT IS IMPORTANT TO DO THAT NOW. Class sizes are limited and registration will be open to the general public on April 23. If you have not registered prior to April 23 and the class is full, there will not be a spot for your child.
