**Construction Crew**—How tall can you build a tower?

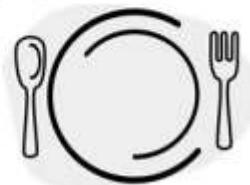
**Family Photo Fun**—Capture the memories in a fun photo booth!
