### **Year End Festivities**

**Wednesday, May 29**

**Grade K-1<sup>st</sup> will be going to the Prosser City Park for lunch and games.** They will leave school at 11:15 a.m. and return at approximately 2:30 p.m.

**Grades 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> will be going to Skateland in Yakima.** They will leave school approximately 11:15 a.m. and return by the end of the school day. Each student is asked to bring \$3.00 to help defray the cost. The remainder of the cost will be paid from the Student Activity Fund. Students will eat their lunch at school before leaving for the skating rink.

**Grades 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> will be going to Hallett Cinemas in Sunnyside to watch “A Dog’s Life”.** They will leave school approximately 8:45 a.m. and return to school for lunch. 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Students are asked to bring \$5.00 to help defray the cost. This will include pop and popcorn, and the remainder of the cost will be paid from the Student Activity Fund.

**Track and Field Day:** Each year, the last day, we have a track and field day for the students. It is a great time to enjoy some healthy competition and to end the school year. The K-5<sup>th</sup> students will participate in track and field events, 6<sup>th</sup> graders will compete in a soccer game, and the 7<sup>th</sup> graders will be running a concession stand. We expect Field Day events to be over between 10:30-11:00 a.m. Please do not take your child(ren) home until ALL their races are complete. There is no bus service following track and field events. Parents, grandparents, you are welcome to join us- put the date on your calendar!

**Hot Lunches:** Please note that Friday, May 24, is the last day for elementary students to purchase hot lunch from the Juniors. Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> & Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup> students will need to bring a sack lunch or purchase limited lunch items from the school store.

**School Service Hours:** Just a reminder that service hours are due prior to the beginning of next school year. Service hours from 2018-2019 that are not completed at that time will be billed \$10/hour on your September tuition statement.

**SCHOOL ATTENDANCE FOR 2019-20 (next year!)** We are currently working on many things for the upcoming 2019-20 school year. *Accurate information is extremely important as we make plans.* IF you, or anyone else you know, has a child who does not currently attend SCS but who may or will attend next year, PLEASE LET THE SCHOOL KNOW AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. ALSO, if you plan to move or leave SCS for any reason, please let us know now so that we can plan accordingly. We appreciate your communication with us.

**2019-2020 Registration** Registration packets were sent out last week. Please keep in mind that Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup> will be the deadline for registration paperwork and Building Use Fee payment to hold your child's spot in next year's classes. **A verbal commitment will not hold a spot—we must have the required paperwork and Building Use Fee payment.**

**School Cleaning:** Lists are included in today's newsletter. **Just a reminder that if you do not sign-up to clean, and have not paid the cleaning fee ahead of time, you will be billed \$225 on your September tuition statement. Cleaning hours also count for service hours!** You are welcome to clean more than the required 3 hours if you are trying to finish up those last few service hours. Thank you!

**K-8 Report Cards** will be ready to be picked up on Thursday, June 6, at the elementary office. A 2019-2020 school calendar and supply list will be included with the report cards.

**Summer Office Hours:** During the month of June, office hours will be Monday thru Thursday, 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., and closed on Fridays. **Ted Brown representatives** will conduct instrument testing with 4th Grade during music class on Tuesday, May 28th. The 4th Grade students will have the opportunity to rate their top 3 choices of the following instruments: *Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet and Trombone*. Students interested in *Percussion* must first talk with Ms. Spear, and also pass required testing. Student preference is considered, though students may not receive their first choice of instrument, based on Ted Brown's and Ms. Spear's knowledgeable assessments. Balance is a necessity when working with any musical group, the same as with sports teams! The following shows a balanced sound based on 24 students: 4 - 6 Flutes, 5 - 6 Clarinets, 4 - 5 Trumpets, 3 - 4 Trombones, 4 Percussion.

ALL INHALERS AND MEDICATIONS WILL BE SENT HOME WITH YOUR CHILD ON WEDNESDAY, May 29<sup>th</sup>. If your child will require inhalers or medications next school year, you will need to bring them to the office with the needed paperwork at the beginning of school (forms are available in the office and will be sent home the beginning of the 18-19 school year). Please note that we will not have inhalers here for Field Day on May 30<sup>th</sup> - please make sure you are prepared that morning.
