2018-2019 Registration: Please keep in mind that **Thursday, June 7th** will be the deadline for registration paperwork and Building Use Fee payment to hold your child's spot in next year's classes. **A verbal commitment will not hold a spot—we must have the required paperwork and Building Use Fee payment.**

School Cleaning: Lists are included in today's newsletter. Just a reminder that if you do not sign-up to clean, and have not paid the cleaning fee ahead of time, you will be billed \$225 on your September tuition statement. Cleaning hours also count for service hours! You are welcome to clean more than the required 3 hours if you are trying to finish up those last few service hours. Thank you!

School Service Hours: Just a reminder that service hours are due prior to the beginning of next school year. Service hours from 2017-2018 that are not completed at that time will be billed \$10/hour on your September tuition statement.

Hot Lunches: Please note that TOMORROW, May 25, is the last day for elementary students to purchase hot lunch from the Close-Up students. Tuesday, May 29th & Wednesday, May 30th students will need to bring a sack lunch or purchase limited lunch items from the school store.

K-8 Report Cards will be ready to be picked up on Thursday, June 7, at the elementary office. A 2018-2019 school calendar and supply list will be included with the report cards.

Summer Office Hours: During the month of June, office hours will be Monday thru Thursday, 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., and closed on Fridays. If you need assistance during the month of July, please contact us via e-mail and we'll try to assist you as soon as possible.
