Boxtops - Boxtops for Education are going digital.

We will still be collecting physical boxtops but the companies are changing over to digital boxtops.

1. Download the Box Tops for Education app onto your phone from Google Play or the App Store.
2. Customize the app to see bonus offers from stores you shop at. The customize button is found at the top of the screen.
3. When you buy participating boxtop products, scan your receipt within 14 days and earn money for SCS. The scanner sometimes takes several tries but will usually work – sometimes you need to zoom in on the relevant parts of the receipt.

Over the course of the Boxtops for Education program, SCS has earned over \$21,500, please continue to help our school in this way. If you have questions, please contact the elementary school office.
