**K-8<sup>th</sup> STUDENT DROP-OFF GUIDELINES:** In order to help prevent student/traffic congestion, we are continuing the plan established last year for students as they arrive at school in the mornings:

- The north parking lot is for BUSES ONLY from 8:00-8:30. Students who ride the bus to school will be using the front entry for admittance into the school building.
- Students who are dropped off at school by parents or others, will be using the east parking lot and will be entering the building through the courtyard
- Please do not drive through the North parking lot to get to the courtyard. Turn into the east parking lot.

**Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> Grades, please note the following bell times.** The first bell rings at 8:30 a.m.; the tardy bell rings at 8:33 a.m. Please plan your morning accordingly. If your children do not ride the bus, please drop them off between 8:15-8:25 a.m. Please have your students here early enough so they have time to get organized and in their classrooms BEFORE the tardy bell. Dismissal time is 3:06 p.m.
