Dear Parents,

We are living in very uncertain times, and we are facing a reality that is very different from anything we have experienced before. We, as a school, are working hard to provide a little bit of stability for both you and your children. I would like to share some things that we are putting in place. Last night the teachers presented to the board a plan to provide extended learning opportunities for the students of Sunnyside Christian School. This plan was approved, so we are ready to move forward.

The elementary and junior high staff are putting together packets for each student. These packets may include worksheets that cover the different subjects, books that can be read at home, activities that parents can do with their children, and online activities. We are planning on having these packets ready to be picked up Thursday, March 19. The packets will be in the gym, sorted by grade levels. Your child's name will be on it. The school has scheduled the following times to be available for you to pick up the packets: 7:00-8:0 AM, 11:00 AM-1:00 PM, and 6:00 – 7:00 PM. In the packets, students will find assignments that should be completed and returned within a week. We will again have scheduled times available next Thursday, March 26, for students to turn in their completed work and to pick up any new assignments that teachers have planned for their students. In the interest of safety and the health of everyone, please maintain the practice of social distancing when you come to pick up your child's work.

The high school teachers have set up online learning activities for each student. The high school will be sending home a letter explaining their plan.

Things have been changing on a regular basis. If things change and we are given a new directive, we will adjust as we need to. Please contact your child's teacher if you have any questions.

We feel this is the best way to help support your children and continue their education during this very difficult time.
