**K-8<sup>th</sup> STUDENT DROP-OFF GUIDELINES:** In order to help prevent student/traffic congestion, we are continuing the plan established for students as they arrive at school in the mornings:

- The north parking lot is for **BUS USE ONLY** from 8:00-8:30. <u>Students who ride the bus to</u> school will be using the front entry for admittance into the school building.
- Students who are dropped off at school by parents or others will be using the east parking lot (enter from N.  $9^{th}$  St. and exit onto North Ave.) and will be entering the building through the courtyard.

#### **Bell Times**

<u>Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> Grades</u>, please note the following bell times. The first bell rings at 8:30 a.m.; the tardy bell rings at 8:33 a.m. Please plan your morning accordingly. If your children do not ride the bus, please drop them off between 8:15-8:25 a.m. Please have your students here early enough so they have time to get organized and in their classrooms BEFORE the tardy bell. <u>Dismissal time is 3:06 p.m.</u>

<u>High School - 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grades, please note the following bell times.</u> The first bell rings at 8:22 a.m.; the tardy bell rings at 8:25 a.m.! You are required to sign in/out in the office anytime you arrive late or leave during the school day. If you arrive after school has started for Periods One (1) and Six (6), you will need an admittance slip from Mrs. Driesen to be admitted to class. If you need to leave in the middle of class, visit Mrs. Driesen BEFOREHAND with your note and get an excuse slip to leave. <u>Dismissal time is 3:15 p.m.</u>

<u>Bus Routes:</u> Keep in mind that pick-up and drop-off times may still fluctuate in the first few weeks of school. Please be patient with our staff and bus drivers as we navigate through these routes. If you are in the neighborhood, please stop by school and pick-up or drop-off your child(ren). If we all work together the buses will save time, miles, and fuel.

**STUDENT PICTURES:** Individual student pictures will be taken for all students in the AM & PM 4 year old preschool class and Kinder thru 12<sup>th</sup> grades on Wednesday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. Student retakes and photos for the 3 year old preschool classes will be taken on October 22<sup>nd</sup>.

<u>7<sup>th</sup> Grade Immunizations</u>: If your 7<sup>th</sup> grader or 8<sup>th</sup> grader has not had a tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis immunization in over 5 years, they must have a Tdap Booster. If you took advantage of the opportunity to take care of this during the summer, please inform Ms. Duim at the elementary office of these updates.

<u>Sports physicals</u> are required for all 6<sup>th</sup> graders, junior high, and senior high students (grades 6-12) <u>participating</u> in <u>interscholastic activities</u>. You must have your physical form turned in before you can participate in practices. Jr. High students- turn your completed physical forms into the office. High <u>School students- turn your completed physical forms into your coach or the high school office</u>. Please take care of getting a physical now. NOTE- WIAA rules make sports physicals good for TWO YEARS.

<u>School Directory</u> - We will be printing and publishing our school directory soon. Parents, please check the information in the FACTS parent portal for accuracy of information. You can access/change information in the Family Portal via online and by logging into the Parent Portal through the App. If you <u>do not</u> wish for some or all of your contact information to be available to school families, please contact the elementary office. The directory will be available via the parent portal and in published form.

**Have you turned in your 2023-2024 Service Hours?** If not, please do so by Friday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. Lost your form? Stop at the elementary office for a new one. All hours not completed will be billed to you at \$10.00 per hour in October.

<u>Newsletters</u>: A weekly school newsletter goes home with the youngest student in each family on Thursdays. We also send an e-mail version of this newsletter to families who provide us with an e-mail address. <u>If you have a family member who would like to stay informed of current school happenings and information, we would be happy to add them to our e-mail list.</u> Simply call the elementary office and provide us with their e-mail address.

With Hot Lunches starting up we will continue implementing the order/payment system through your FACTS parent portal. You, the parents, can prepay through the financial tab. Cash at the time of ordering will still be accepted, but we would like to try and move away from cash payments for hot lunch. Hot lunch orders can be placed directly through the lunch tab in your parent portal or the lunch icon through the school app. With your permission, your child may place their order at school with their teacher and the teacher can enter the order online. Parents of high schoolers can place orders online too. High School students who have online orders will need to follow instructions that are listed in the daily announcements.
