PSAT Exam: The PSAT or Preliminary SAT is a practice test that Sophomores and Juniors can take to prepare for college entrance exams. It also provides useful insight on whether students' academic skills are on track for college readiness. The PSAT will be given Wednesday, October 16 during the school day. This year students will take the test using their chrome books and must be registered before the testing date.
