Bus drivers may call a snow route for their area only- you will be notified by your bus driver if that situation develops. Also, if you are **NOT** planning to ride the bus, PLEASE CALL or TEXT YOUR DRIVER by 6:45 AM. When roads are slick and travel is slower, they appreciate knowing that information ahead of time so they can plan accordingly.
